Welcome!

Thank you for supporting your school and the competition today. I wish your team/s the very best for the day and trust they will not only enjoy their games but have fun learning.

### To assist with smooth running today

- ☺ **Reminder, if players have any questions during their game they can put up their hand and an official will visit them**
- ☺ **Players must stay seated and quiet until the end of the round, including adjudications**
- ☺ **No adults are permitted in the playing area during the round and adjudications**

These competitions are about positive attitude. Here are some things adults can do to help set the right tone and ensure the success of the day.

- ☺ Be a positive role model for their students
- ☺ Insist that their students play within the rules and by the Fairplay Principles
- ☺ Display self-control on the sideline. Let the students play and enjoy their games
- ☺ Respect students' efforts regardless of whether they have won or lost
- ☺ Encourage respect for the opposition and officials
- ☺ Accept the decisions of officials
- ☺ Show appreciation to people who give their time so their students can take part
- ☺ Always be positive.
